Bid for new lockers: \$31,000.00. We currently do not have a projected date to when the installments of the lockers will take place. The walk through with the locker company is on Thursday, 11/19. From there, we will get a possible date for installation.

There were talks about adding new technology in the individual lockers such as a charging station. But we are not going forward with that due to possible risk in theft.

The height of the new lockers will be 3 feet tall. From the current lockers the depth will be an extra 3 inches and the width will be an extra 6 inches.
